



Our Summer Camp will be Fully booked again this Summer!

The Parking lot is going to be PACKED every day!

Please Drive Slowly & Watch out for Children!

Please be Courteous and Quick at drop off & pick up.

Park against the fence and do not block the driveway.

Campers Need to bring the following items in their backpack daily:

- A healthy LUNCH in a lunchbox with an ice pack
- LABELED INSULATED water bottle filled with ICE & WATER
- LABELED Bottle of bug spray in a Ziploc bag
- Spare set of clothing in a gallon Ziploc bag
- Rain coat with a hood (No umbrellas)
- PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING WITH YOUR CHILD'S FIRST NAME!!!
- PLEASE DRESS FOR MESS! EVERY DAY IS MESSY PLAY DAY!
- Remember that children and clothing are WASHABLE!
- Campers will be very wet and dirty at pick up time!
- We have a Wash off station with a hose out front for your convenience.
- Please keep a beach towel in your car to protect from wet campers on the ride home.
- The DIRT will wash away but the memories will last a lifetime!
- Summer camp is a great place to make new friends & kindness counts here!
- We do not allow aggressive behavior of any kind at Summer camp.
- Children who exhibit the inability to follow rules or show aggressive behavior will be dismissed immediately.
- The safety of the children attending our camp is our number 1 priority above all else.
- Camp is not appropriate for children with individual needs beyond our camp counselors training.
- This camp is set up for children ages 3-8 Only!
- Campers MUST BE 100% potty trained and able to use the bathroom independently including wiping.
- Children who cannot follow directions & be cooperative in a large group will be unable to attend.
- To maintain a low camper-to-counselor ratio, campers are split into smaller groups as needed.
- Every effort will be made not to close camp unless we have inclement weather or severe heat indexes.
- Campers should come dressed for the day's weather and be ready to be outside in all safe weather.
- Parent's must apply SUNSCREEN AT HOME BEFORE COMING TO CAMP!
- Watch the daily weather report and dress your camper for the expected weather forecast.
- In extreme weather or heat indexes, we will CLOSE CAMP and give notice as soon as possible. Rest assured that watching out for bad weather is part of our program and we take this responsibility seriously.
- Balancing the children's safety with fun outdoor experiences is always on our minds.
- Exploring Nature is the best way for children to learn to love the outdoors. To maintain a safe environment, children must be able to follow safety rules that include but are not limited to the following: 1. Stay with the group 2. Listen to directions 3. Stay within designated camp areas on trails and within base camp.
- **It is your responsibility to apply sunscreen and bug repellent before dropping off at camp each day.**
- We will reapply bug spray as needed before going to the Fairytale Forest.
- Remember to check your child/children at the end of camp each day for ticks.
